REGARDING RELAXATION OF UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR REGISTRATION IN  
PROGRAMMES MBBS (CODE 103), BAMS (CODE 153), BHMS (CODE 154) & B.SC.  
(H) NURSING (CODE 115) FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2021-22

All the concerned students/stake holders are hereby informed that the upper age limit of 25 years (on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission) as detailed in the Admission Brochure 2021-22 has been removed conditionally by the University for the purpose of submission of online application forms. Thus, the candidates above 25 years are provisionally permitted to register in GGSIPU for the programmes MBBS, BAMS, BHMS & B.Sc. (H) Nursing, however, their candidature for admission will be subject to the outcome of pending petitions before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The above relaxation in the upper age limit is implied for registration only in the medical programmes such as MBBS, BAMS, BHMS and B.Sc. (H) Nursing, the admission of whose are to be carried out by the University on the basis of NEET UG 2021.

The aforesaid matter is pending adjudication before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the authorities/University shall abide by any order that may be passed for NEET UG 2021.
